Lesson 38: Ow= long o sound

Phonics Rule: Ow has two sounds:

- 1. The pinch sound as in cow
- 2.Long o sound as in low or snow

There is no way for the eye to tell which sound to use. Be prepared to use whichever sound makes sense in the context of the sentence.

Ow as in snow or low

show	slow	elbow
snow	own	yellow
snowed	owe	pillow
throw	owner	follow
glow	mower	shad/ow
crow	be/low	win/dow
spar/row	ar/row	fel/low
	snow snowed throw glow	snow own snowed owe throw owner glow mower

The word "bow" is tricky. This word can be pronounced both ways, so it must be used in context. Is it a hair bow, or a bow and arrow, or shoe strings tied in a bow? Or is a person taking a bow or bowing their knees in worship?

- 9. Do not lie.
- Do not cov/et what belongs to other people.

Exodus 20:1-17

- ¹And God spake all these words, saying,
- ²I am the Lord thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage.
- ³ Thou shalt have no other gods before me.
- ⁴Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth.
- ⁵ Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the Lord thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me;
- ⁶ And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.
- ⁷Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain; for the Lord will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.
- ⁸ Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy.
- ⁹ Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work:

- ¹⁰ But the seventh day is the sabbath of the Lord thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates:
- ¹¹ For in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the Lord blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.
- ¹² Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.
- ¹³ Thou shalt not kill.
- ¹⁴ Thou shalt not commit adultery.
- ¹⁵ Thou shalt not steal.
- ¹⁶ Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.
- ¹⁷ Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbour's.
