Lesson 59: Final Phonics Rules

Phonics Rule: When the vowels "o" and "i" are followed by two consonants, the vowels are long.

Phonics Rule: "ull" says the same vowel sound as in "foot":

pull full bull bully pulley

pullet

Other words with the same vowel sound are:

put push bush bushel butcher

pudding cush/ion am/bush

The suffix "ful" also says "u" as in "foot":

care/ful beau/ti/ful de/light/ful aw/ful

won/der/ful wist/ful wor/ship/ful pow/er/ful

joyful peace/ful faith/ful tact/ful

Phonics Rule: Before "e", "i", or "y", the consonant blend "sc" has a "soft c" sound, so it simply sounds like "s":

scent scissors scene scen/er/y

science sci/en/tist sci/en/tif/ic dis/ci/ple

scepter lu/scious mis/cel/la/ne/ous fas/cin/ate

a/dol/e/scent fluor/es/cent

Phonics Rule: The consonant "x" has three sounds:

- 1. At the end of a word or syllable, it says "ks".
- 2. With "ex", it says "gz".
- 3. At the beginning of words, it says, "z".

X at the end of a word or syllable:

Phonics Rule: EA is a vowel team for short e. It's the only time a vowel team is used for a short vowel:

bread head deaf breath

bear lead dread death

realm thread heavy ready

break/fast weather wearing already

instead feather Heaven meadow

clean/li/ness measure pleasure

ear = er

earn learn earth heard

pearl early earth/quake earth/worm

re/hear/sal earnest yearn search

re/search un/heard search/light earthly

Exceptions: heart, hearken, hearth, beard,

JESUS Said, "Follow Me and Be My Disciple"


healed many people, including those who were blind, deaf, and lame. Once, he turned water into wine. Another time, he took five loaves of bread and two fish that a child offered and mul/ti/plied the food to feed a crowd of over five thousand people! He served the people earn/est/ly, often

working to the point of ex/haus/tion. Some/times, there were so many people coming and going that He didn't even have time to eat! JESUS was a com/pas/sion/ate, wonderful, loving, joyful, peaceful, patient, kind, good, faithful, gentle, meek man who ex/hib/it/ed in/cred/ible self-control. When he was offered all the kingdoms of the earth if he would simply fall down and worship the devil, JESUS quickly refused, pushing back and saying, "Get behind

Me, Satan, for the Scriptures say, 'You must worship the LORD your God and serve only Him.'" JESUS ful/filled his des/tin/y on earth, dying on the cross to take away our sins, and then GOD the FATHER gave Him the scep/ter of au/thor/i/ty over all of Heaven and all of the kingdoms of the earth. JESUS received the eternal position of KING of Kings and LORD of Lords by obeying GOD, not by the awful act of being wor/ship/ful of the devil.

JESUS calls every/one ev/ery/where to follow Him and be His dis/ci/ple. He wants us to love GOD with all our hearts, souls, minds, and strength; and to love people just like He does. He wants us to be strong in char/ac/ter. He wants us worship GOD and search for GOD dil/i/gent/ly. He wants us to become a true friend of GOD.

When we do, it will be like finding a great treasure or a pearl of great price, because be/live/ing in JESUS for sal/va/tion and becoming His friend is what gives us eternal



life and opens up all the riches of Heaven for us. If you have JESUS, you have EVERYTHING you ever need, forever!!! If you don't have JESUS, you have nothing. It is a heavy thought, but one we must all face: death comes to all of hu/man/ity. However, if you have believed on the LORD JESUS CHRIST for your salvation, instead of going to the grave when you die, your spirit will simply move to Heaven! You will be es/cort/ed by the angels to the Throne Room of GOD, where you will behold the glory of GOD MOST HIGH, the

LORD JESUS CHRIST, and the HOLY SPIRIT! It will be so exciting to be with our CREATOR! It will exceed anything you have ever thought or imagined! You will get to talk with GOD face-to-face, and be His dear, close friend, forever!!!!

JESUS tells us to repent of our sins and turn to GOD. That means we are supposed to tell GOD that we are sorry for all the



unkind, bad things that we have done in our life, STOP doing those things, and start loving people in the way that GOD loves them: by being kind, merciful, com/pas/sion/ate, and forgiving. Romans 10:9-13 explains what we are to do if we want to follow JESUS and ex/per/i/ence eternal

life: "If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by openly de/clar/ing your faith that you are saved. As the Scriptures tell us, 'Anyone who trusts in him will never be dis/graced.' Jew and Gentile are the same in this respect. They have the same Lord, who gives gen/er/ous/ly to all who call on him. For 'everyone who calls on the name of the LORD will be saved.'"

JESUS also says in Mark 16:16, "Anyone who believes and is bap/tized will be saved. But anyone who refuses to believe will be con/demned."

JESUS wants EVERYONE to be saved! 1 Timothy 2:3-4 says that He is "...God our Savior, who wants everyone to be saved and to un/der/stand the truth."

You were BORN to be a beloved friend of GOD. You exist to worship Him. When you repent of your sins and accept JESUS as your LORD and SAVIOR, you begin walking down the path that leads to your destiny – the high calling of GOD in CHRIST JESUS for you – which is to be one of JESUS' Best Friends. Would you like to make the best de/ci/sion of your life right now? Would you like to choose to follow JESUS and be His disciple forever? If so, you can pray something like this:

"LORD JESUS, I am so sorry for all the bad, unkind things that I have done in life. Would You please forgive me and make me clean? I believe that You died on the cross to pay the pun/ish/ment for my sins. I believe that You were in the grave for three days and that then GOD raised You from the dead. I believe that you are now alive forever! I boldly say to all people that You are my LORD and KING! I love You and I want to follow You and be Your disciple forever! Please teach me how to love You and love others. Please teach me how to be kind, merciful, and good. Please send Your HOLY SPIRIT to fill me up and empower me to live this new life of love with You. I love You, LORD JESUS. In Your Holy Name I pray. Amen."

If you prayed that prayer and really meant it, then JESUS has written your name in His *LAMB'S BOOK OF LIFE*, and you are saved!!! The angels in Heaven are throwing a party, rejoicing, and dancing because you are now one of JESUS' followers and a child of GOD!!!! You are the prodigal son or daughter who has returned home! You are the lost sheep that has been found! You are the Bride that JESUS paid the most ex/pen/sive price of His own blood on the cross to purchase. You are so valuable to JESUS!!!! Your i/den/ti/ty is pre/cious, and your des/tin/y is POWERFUL!!!!

The next thing you will want to do is to find a good church that believes in JESUS, GOD the FATHER, and the HOLY SPIRIT, and ask to be baptized. Baptism publicly shows everyone that you have made a de/ci/sion to die to your old life of sin and self/ish/ness, and that you are being raised up to live a new life of love by following JESUS and being His disciple. Your old sinful nature is buried in the waters of baptism, and you become a new creature in CHRIST JESUS when you come up out of the water!

Then you will want to ask the pastor or elder to pray for you to receive the gift of the HOLY SPIRIT. JESUS told the disciples in Acts 1:8, "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere — in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." He also said in Luke 11:13, "So if you sinful

people know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him." So, ASK Him!!! The Holy Spirit will help you to be bold, kind, and loving, and will help you fulfill your wonderful destiny in life!

Finally, you will want to set up a daily ap/point/ment with JESUS to spend time with Him. It takes time and effort to become a faithful disciple and Best Friend of JESUS. As Gary and Dr. Greg Smalley say in their book, *Bound by Honor*, "Friendships don't develop by chance or accident, but as a result of [our purposefully] spending time together regularly." It is a great idea to set aside the first hour of your day every day to sing a song to JESUS, read one chapter of the Bible, and talk to JESUS about whatever is on your heart. As you do, JESUS will begin to per/son/al/ly teach you how to follow Him and love others. You will grow a little bit every day. After many years, you will become just like JESUS: you will be loving, joyful, peaceful, patient, kind, good, faithful, gentle, meek, and self-controlled. You will be a very happy, fulfilled person! A life lived with JESUS is an amazing, excellent life!
