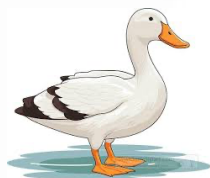


Lesson 8: Short o Word List

Bob's Pets



Bob had a big, fat, red hen and a duck in a bent pen. A big red fox ran to hop in the pen. The fox will get the hen and the duck. “Quack, quack!” went the duck.

“Cluck, cluck!” went the hen.

Bob yelled, “Help! Stop, fox, stop!”



The pet dog is in his box. Spot the Dog ran at the fox as fast as a jet. The dog bit the fox on the leg. The fox will hop on top of a log. The fox hid from the dog. The fox left.

Bob will fix the bent pen. Bob can tap on the top of the pen. Bob will fix the pen to stop the fox. The duck is glad. The hen is glad. Bob is glad. The fox is not.

COMPREHENSION QUESTIONS:

1. Why was the fox able to get into the pen?
2. What did Bob do about this problem?
3. Why were the duck and hen glad?
