


The Development of Communication



Years ago, people communicated with each other mostly by writing letters. Then came the **telegraph**. It allowed faster



communication over long distances by sending messages by Morse Code. After that, the **telephone** was invented. Suddenly, people could hear their friends and talk with them in real time!



People could have **telephones** in their own homes! These new **phones** were connected by wires. **Telephone** poles carried the wires all over the country.
