

## Lesson 15: Short to Long Vowels with a Final Silent E

**Phonics Rule:** When there are two vowels in a word, and one is a final silent e, the silent e jumps over the consonant or blend and makes the vowel say its Long Sound. The pattern is: **Consonant/Vowel/Consonant/"e"**.

Directions: Practice this list. First, read the short vowel word, then read its corresponding long vowel word, saying, "The vowel says A, the word says BATE."

# GOD Made Man



GOD is big. GOD is kind. GOD is **nice**. GOD wanted to **make** a man. GOD **made** a man with dust. He **made** a man with a **face**, a **nose**, and a **spine**. GOD **gave** the man **life** and **gave** him the **name** “Adam”. GOD **smiled**. He **liked** the man.

Adam **takes care** of the pets. Adam **cares** for the cats, the dogs, the hens, the frogs, the ducks, the fish, the **apes**, the rab/bits, and the **mice**. Adam is sad. The cat has a **mate**. gal. He **names** her **Eve**. She is Adam's **wife**. GOD **smiles**. GOD **likes** Adam and **Eve**.

Adam and **Eve** made a **cute** hut to be a **home**.

Adam and **Eve** got **ripe grapes** and **ate** them.



Adam and **Eve** made a **kite**.

Adam and **Eve** run a **race**. It was a **mile**.

Adam and **Eve** run the **race** and cross the fin/ish **line** at the **same time**!

Adam **made** a **fire**. **Eve** **baked** a **cake**. It is a **nice** cake with **dates**, **cloves**, and **spice**. Adam cuts a **slice** of **cake** and **takes** a **bite**. He **ate** it. He is glad.

Adam and **Eve** go with GOD to the **lake**. **Eve** picks a **rose**. Adam picks up a **pine cone**. GOD picks up a duck. "Quack, quack!" GOD **smiles**. He **likes** the duck.



It is **time** for GOD to go. "I will be back," He tells Adam and **Eve**. Adam **smiles**. He **likes** GOD. 😊

## COMPREHENSION QUESTIONS:

1. Who created Adam and Eve?
2. Adam was lonely. How did GOD fix that problem?
3. What was one fun thing that Adam and Eve did together?
