Tim went to **swim**. Tim and his dad sat on the **brick** wall in the sun to sip a **drink** of pop and **snack** on **gum/drops**. Dad was hot. Dad went to his **truck** to get a hat. Dad's **truck** was **stuck** in the mud! "Huff" went dad. Tim had to run to get his dog Jep and his dog **sled**. He had to run six **blocks**. Tim had to tell mom, "Dad got his **truck stuck** in the mud at Sam's Mill."



Mom had to fix the **sled** for Jep to **pull**. The **sled** had logs and big **blocks** that dad had **split** with his ax. Mom had to **slip** a **string** to fix a red **flag** to the **sled** with a **clamp**. Jep the dog had to tug the **sled**. He did not **stop**. Jep went **fast** back to Sam's Mill. "Run, Jep, Run!" Jep the dog



ran and did not **stop**. The red **flag** went “**slap, slap**” as Jep ran!

Tim and Jep got to Sam’s Mill fast. Dad got the **blocks** and Tim got a log from the **sled**. Bit by bit, dad’s **truck** got **unstuck**. Dad and Tim got the log and **blocks** back in the **sled**. Dad, Tim, and Jep the dog had a **snack** and a **drink** on the big, red **brick wall**. Dad was **glad** and Tim was **glad**!

COMPREHENSION QUESTIONS:

1. Why did Tim and his dad go to Sam’s Mill?
2. How did Jep the dog help to get the truck out of the mud?
3. What did Tim and his dad do after they got the truck unstuck?
