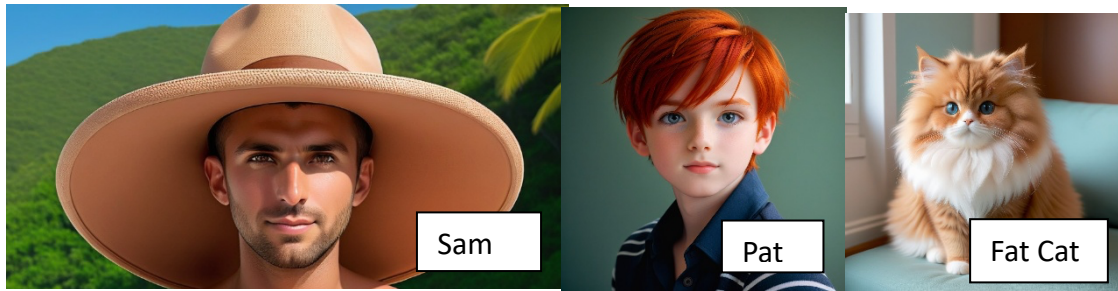


Lesson 5: Short A
