Directions: Have the student read this word list, read the stories, and answer the questions.

Notes: The word “give” in this story has the short “i” sound. The “e” is silent, but is used because no English words end in the letter “v.” Also, explain to the student that an apostrophe plus the letter “s” shows possession.

Jim is sad. His pet pig is sick. Jim can tell the pig is sick. The pig has a rip in his leg. Can Bill the vet help the pig? The vet can pet the pig and can lift the pig's leg. Yes, the vet can help the pig. The vet did fix the pig's leg and will give him a pill and will help him get well. Jim can jig and is glad.

COMPREHENSION QUESTIONS:

1. What gift did Jim's dad give him?
2. Who helped Jim when the pig got sick?
3. What is a jig?
