

Lesson 4: Short Vowel Words

Phonics Rule: Every word must have a vowel. When there is one vowel in a word and a consonant on both sides, the vowel is short. The vowel says ____, the word says ____. (For example:

The vowel says **ă**, the word says “cat”. Or, the vowel says **ĕ**, the word says “bed”.)

Directions: Have the student sound out the word using the phonetic pictures. Then have him read the uppercase version of the word. Finally, have him read the lowercase version of the word. If you have the flashcards, you can have the child build these words.

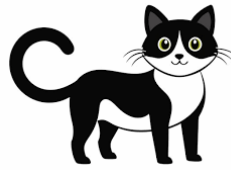
