Lesson 25: Adding ing to Words

Ing is a suffix added at the end of a root word to make a new word. If you add **ing** to a word ending in silent **e**, drop the **e**, then add **ing**. Even though the silent **e** is gone, the main vowel will still say its long sound. If the word has a short vowel in it, we often double the consonant before adding **ing**.
